




Figure 2: Teacher's communicate clearly and inspire students by his/her teaching




Figure 4: Teacher's use Modern Teaching Aids, Handouts, suitable References, Power Point Presentations, Web Resources etc.








Figure 6: The Evaluation Process is Fair and Unbiased







Figure 7: Regular and Timely Feedback is given on Students performance





Figure 8: Results and Attendance records are displayed on time






Figure 10: College Administration is Supportive and Fulfils the Needs of Students








Figure 12: The Library Staff is Cooperative and Helpful







Figure 13: Internet Facilities are Available in the Campus 107 Responses





Figure 14: The Office Staff of the College is Helpful





Figure 15: Clean Drinking Water is Available in the Campus 107 Responses





Figure 16: Toilets/Washrooms are Hygienic and Well-Maintained






Figure 18: The Campus is Green and Eco-Friendly











Figure 3: Teacher's Encourage Participation and Discussion in Class 125 Responses







Figure 5: Teacher's Attitude towards Students is Helpful and Friendly 125 Responses





Figure 6: The Evaluation Process is Fair and Unbiased










Figure 10: College Administration is Supportive and Fulfils the Needs of Students


Figure 12: The Library Staff is Cooperative and Helpful



Figure 13: Internet Facilities are Available in the Campus 125 Responses








Figure 16: Toilets/Washrooms are Hygienic and Well-Maintained












Figure 2: Teacher's communicate clearly and inspire students by his/her teaching








Figure 4: Teacher's use Modern Teaching Aids, Handouts, suitable References, Power Point Presentations, Web Resources etc.




















Figure 16: Toilets/Washrooms are Hygienic and Well-Maintained


Figure 17: Grievances/Problems are Redressed/Solved well in the Classroom 126 Responses


Figure 18: The Campus is Green and Eco-Friendly










Figure 2: Overall Infrastructural Facilities








Figure 4: Library








Figure 6: Office Staff






Figure 2: Examination System








Figure 4: Contents and Design of the Curriculum








Figure 6: Library








Figure 4: Contents and Design of the Curriculum








Figure 2: Examination System








Figure 4: Contents and Design of the Curriculum
































