2018to 2023 Vermicomposting



Sonari College started vermicomposting in 2016. It was planned and executed by Mr. Mintoo Kumar Gogoi, Associate Professor and Coordinator of IQAC, Sonari College. We know that vermicomposting is an organic and biological process in which earthworm species are primarily used to convert organic matter or biodegradable wastes into manure. The produced vermicomposts are rich in nutrition, and thus, they are widely used as biofertilizers in organic farming and sewage treatment plants. That is why Sonari College also planned to produce vermicompost for the kitchen gardens of both the hostels and the flower gardens of Sonari College, which are in the college premises. The department of Botany and the department of Zoology students are engaged with this plan. 70 students are involved in it.







2018to 2023 Kitchen Garden



The hostel boarders of Sonari College started a kitchen garden in the backside of the hostel superintendent house and in front of the girls' hostel in 2017. The basic purpose of setting up this garden is to supply fresh and nutritious vegetables for the hostel boarders. More than 60 students are involved with this work. They have planned and tried to grow all the seasonal vegetables in this garden.







2018to 2023 Plantation of medicinal plant

2021-2022 National Seminar






